Today Catherine Constable Maxwell Stuart, the 21st Lady of Traquair, manages this most aristocratic of microbreweries, located in Scotland's oldest continually inhabited house.

Our warehouse in Lausanne is an old wine cellar, with constant temperature and conditions ideal for beer storage.

It's here we prepare our selection of mixed cases, simply named after Scottish rivers – Avon, Don, Esk, Tay, Tweed and Ythan.

The KeyKeg system protects the beer, facilitates its transportation and prolongs its life cycle. This unique one-way system ensures the products are never exposed to propellant gases.

The technology also guarantees optimal protection during filling, loading, transport and storage.

Storage conditions in our depot, a former wine cellar, are ideally suited for looking after beers – constant low temperatures, no air currents, and never any direct sunlight.

It's cool, peaceful and calm, where bats and beers happily cohabit, in perfect harmony.
